3. Important events include:

- (a) Walking on water (Matthew 14:22-36)
- (b) Confession of faith (Matthew 16:13-23)
- (c) Boasted about being willing to die with Christ, then denial (Matthew 26:31-35)
- (d) Repentance (Matthew 26:35)
- (e) Sermon at Pentecost (Act 2)
- (f) Heals a lame man (Acts 3)

1. We have a living hope because of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

- (a) The hope comes from God Himself

- (d) The hope is secured by Christ's sacrifice.



2. We have an assuring hope because of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

3. We have a hope that keeps us going through every trial because of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
4. We have a hope centered in a Person, Jesus Christ, because of the resurrection.
